As the European Transatlantic Championship in Strasbourg will start om Saturday and some of the players will go there, this Nordic Championship will take place in the middle of the week, Tuesday to Thursday.

To Örebro you can go by car or by train from Denmark and Norway. From Iceland and the Faroe Islands you can choose to fly either to Stockholm or to Copenhagen and take the train from there. From Finland you can take the ferry or fly to Stockholm and take the train from there.

31st of March Inform about team rosters, accommodation and food restrictions

19th **of April** Inform travel itinerary & send pictures for your presentation

15th **of May** Send your convention cards
